

## **BRIGITTE THÉRIAULT**

Brigitte Thériault was born in Quebec in 1974. Her passion for photography began at the age of fourteen, leading her, in later years, to study photography and cinema at Concordia University.

Thériault opened her own studio in Quebec City and became a professional photographer; collaborating with a wide spectrum of clients.

The photographer's true passion remains the discovery of nature's wonder while traveling the globe. According to the artist "travels and photos are inseparable." She uses a traditional approach: shooting slides or films, mainly with a 6x7 inch format camera. Her carefully selected images are then retouched by using computer programs such as Photoshop, allowing the artist to give each photograph her unique flare. The style, atmosphere, and even the colour of her photographic works are then transformed to create a world governed by both the real and imaginary. Thériault takes immense pleasure in presenting nature in its purest, simplest form. The artist excels in capturing the essence of life. She reveals the most intimate secrets of nature through her poetic landscapes.
